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INTERNATIONAL CHESS (G1 and G2 only)

Language: Chinese	Time: 3.40 – 4.30pm
Description: <p>Chess is a game of art, science, knowledge and inspiration. It is a combination of leisure and intellectual training.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Chess Skill and stereoscopic: Chess is a space thinking game because chess pieces are three-dimensional. Three-dimensional are important elements for students to learn mathematics and geometry.2. Chess and Memory: In a chess game, each chess piece has a different value. Chess player needs to have a precise calculation when they exchange chess piece with their rival in order to make sure to get benefit situation.3. Chess players need to think about their next steps and all the possible steps their rival can do. Through this thinking process, children can enhance their reasoning and analysis ability.
